SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS AND WARNINGS

Before using this item, read and follow all safety instructions and warnings. If these instructions are ignored, there is a possibility of a hazardous fire that could result in physical injury or property damage.

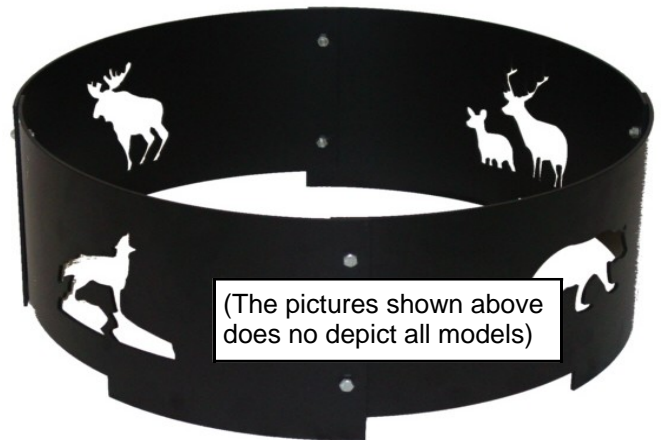
DANGER

- This item is for **OUTDOOR USE ONLY**.
- Metal surfaces may become **VERY HOT** during use! **ALWAYS** use insulated protective gloves or tongs when handling metal parts.
- Before using this item, contact local fire officials regarding potential restrictions.
- Before lighting your fire, **BE SURE** to choose a location that is approved for campfires and at a safe distance from any buildings, trees, grass, or other combustible materials.
- **DO NOT** burn fires during high winds which could carry sparks to other flammable materials.
- **NEVER** use in enclosed unventilated spaces (e.g., garages, sheds, breezeways, etc.) as this could lead to carbon monoxide poisoning, resulting in injury or even death.
- **NEVER** light a fire on any combustible surface, including wood or synthetic decking, boats, rooftops, etc.
- When lighting or rebuilding your fire, **DO NOT** use any chemical accelerant, such as gasoline, alcohol, diesel fuel, kerosene, paint thinner, and charcoal lighter.
- **NEVER** use any aerosol sprays near the fire, including hair spray, cleaning products, paint, etc.

Warnings

- Exercise the same precautions you would with any open fire.
- Seasoned hardwood is recommended. Avoid using any materials in this product that could cause sparks or hot airborne debris.
- Keep children, pets and handicapped persons away from this product when in use or hot.
- Do not leave this product unattended when the unit is in use or hot.
- Watch for potential sharp edges.

Assembly Instructions

Stand the four sides of the fire ring up in a circle, overlapping the ends of sides so the bolt holes in the mating parts line up. Assemble fire ring by installing hex head bolts from the outside. Loosely install the nuts on all the bolts before tightening. Once all the bolts and nuts are installed, tighten the nuts.

Care Once the fire ring is cooled, wipe with a damp rag. Storage of the fire ring out of the weather will prolong the finish. This product will weather to a natural oxidized finish. The unit can be repainted with high temperature barbecue paint if desired.

Limited Warranty

- Round the Campfire (R T.C.) warrants to the original purchaser of this product that it will be free of defects in material or workmanship for a period of two (2) year from the date of purchase.
- This warranty covers product failure due to defects in material or workmanship only.
